

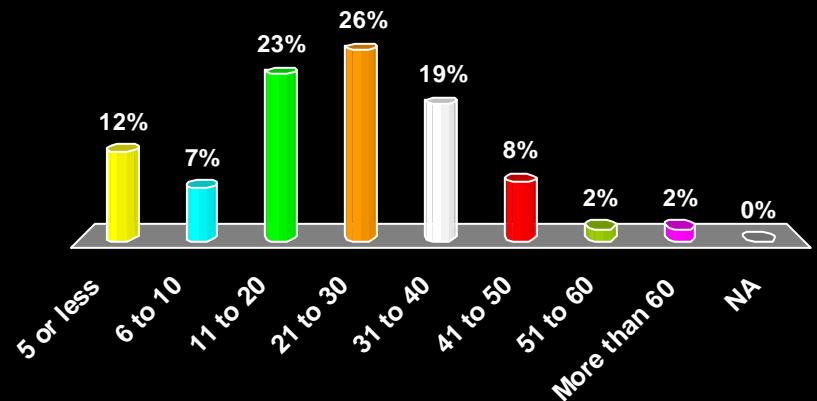

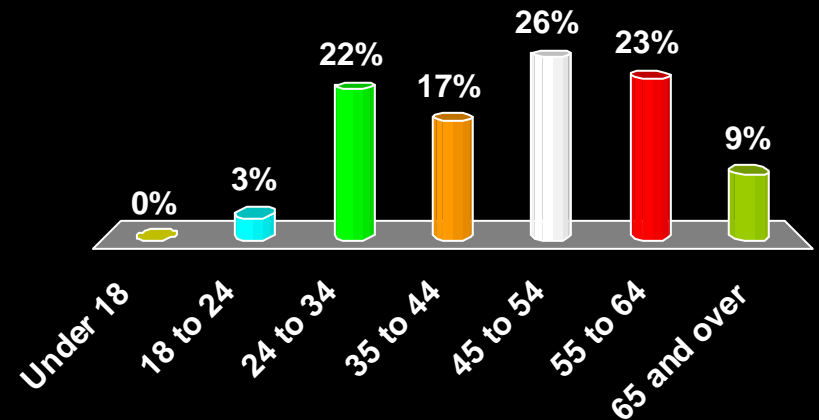

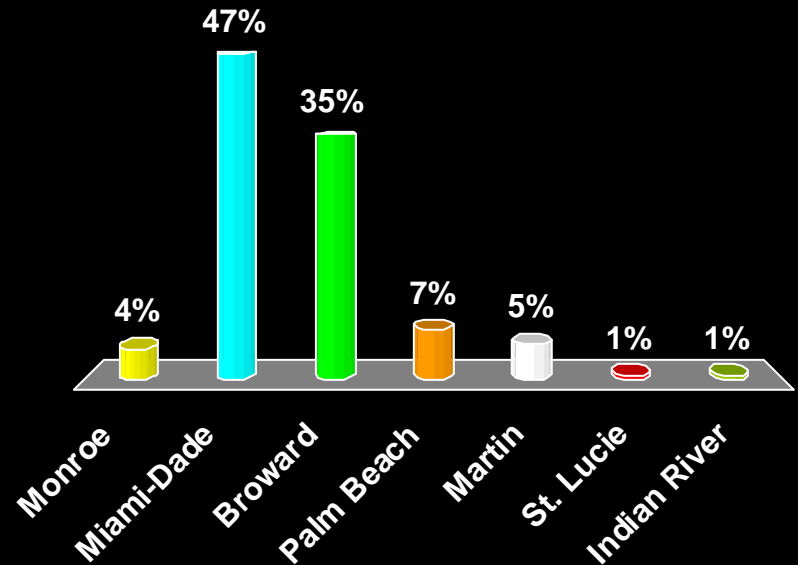

Should Broward County change its name to Fort Lauderdale County?

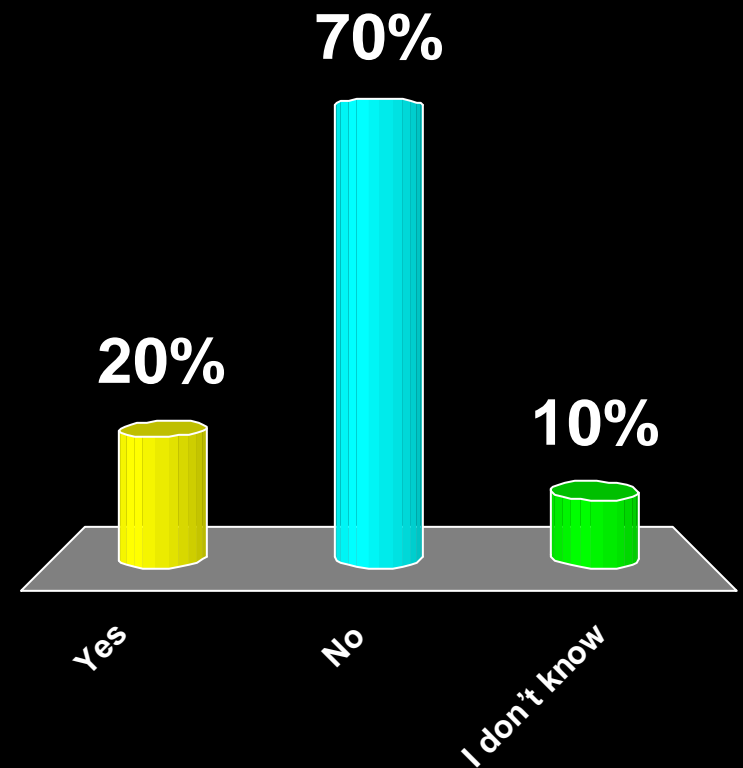
Broward County got its name from Napoleon Bonaparte Broward the governor in 1905.

An independent researcher has been invited to weigh in.

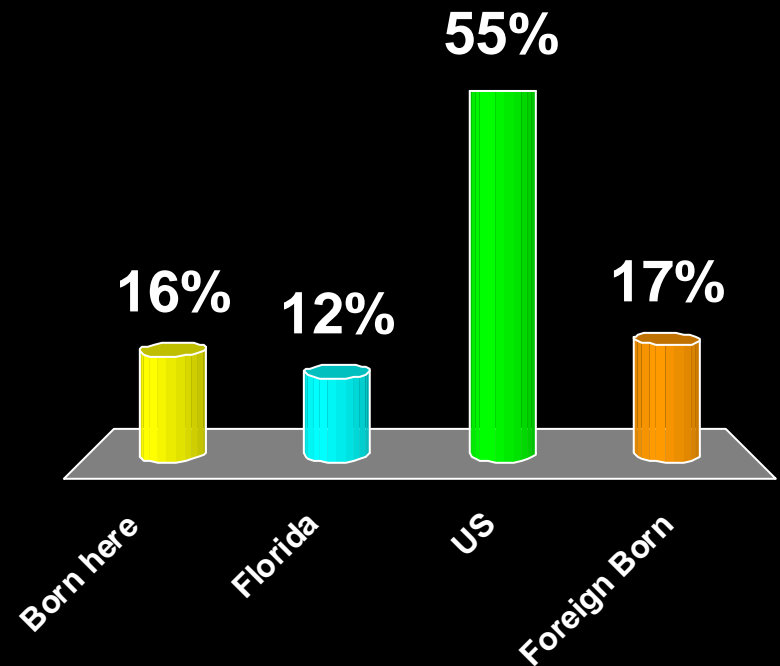

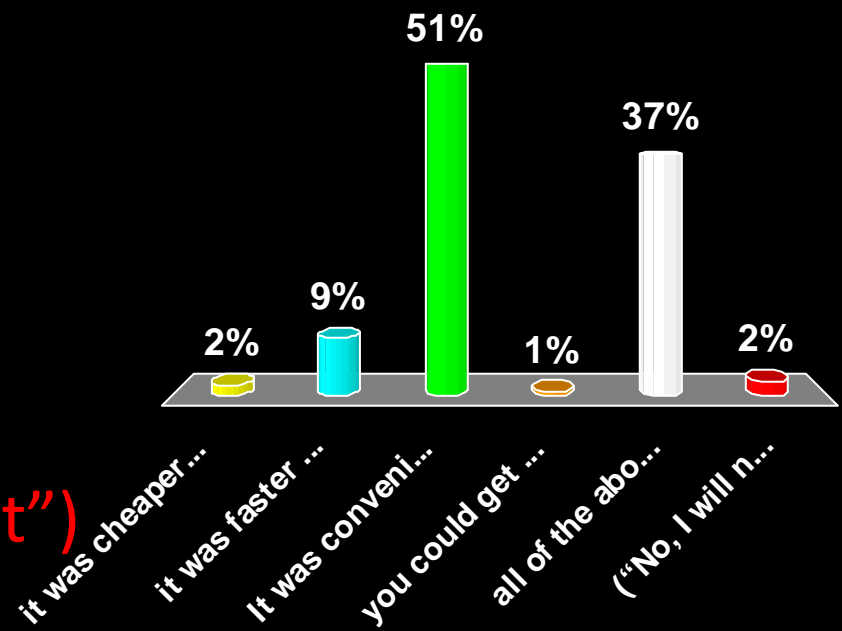

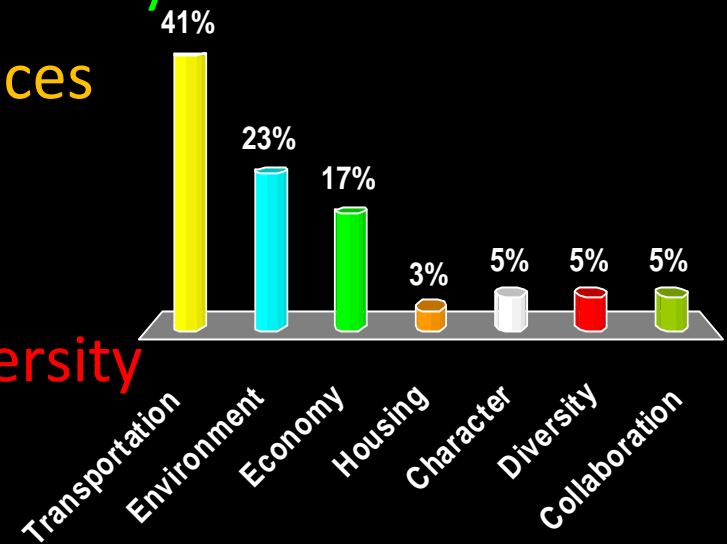

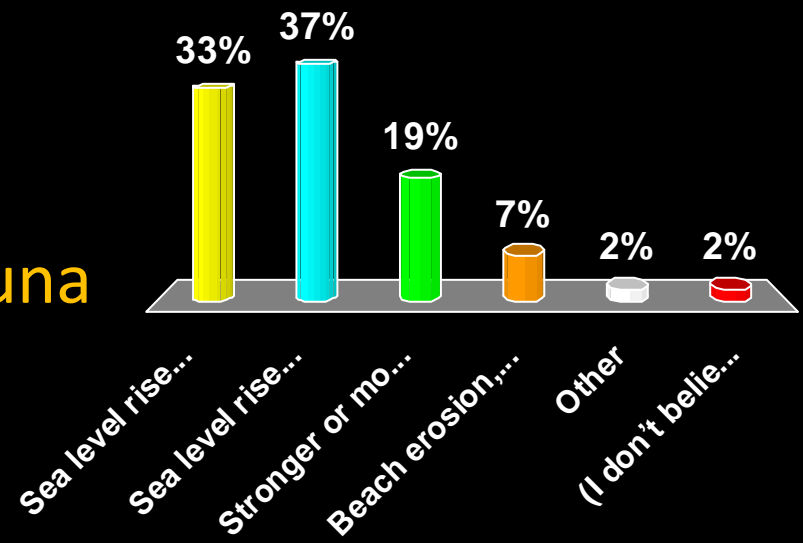
If you had \$100 to spend on addressing just one regional priority, how would you spend/donate your money?

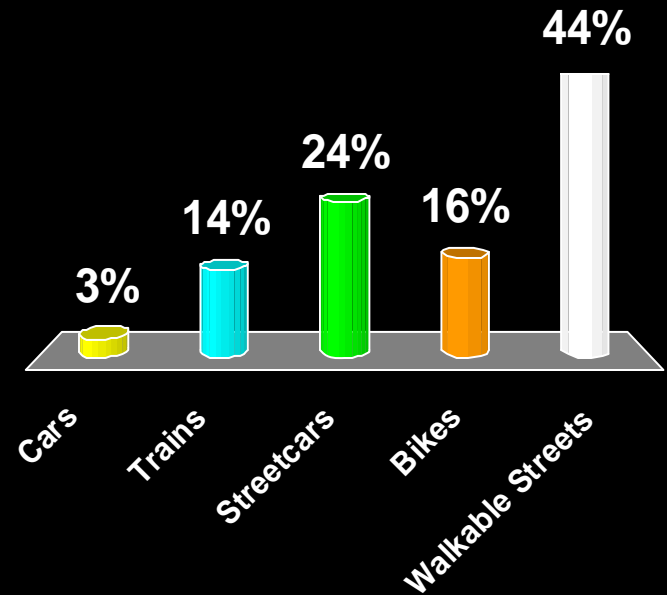

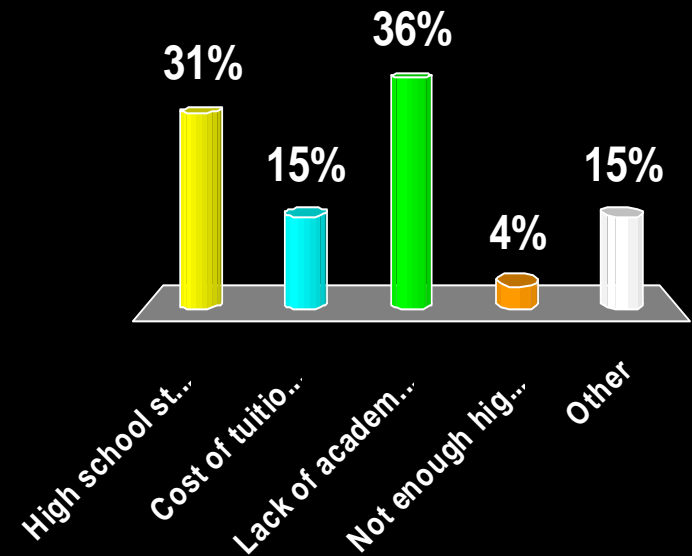
In addition to maintenance costs of existing transportation facilities, we should invest in... (Pick 2)
